Below rule 112 *insert* the following:—

Note 1.—The Commissioners of Divisions have been authorised to sanction daily allowance for continuous halts in excess of ten days at any one place up to a limit of thirty days. The grant of such allowance in excess of thirty days requires the sanction of Government.

Note 2.—In according their sanction as above, the sanctioning authorities may reduce the rate of daily allowance to any extent that may appear to them to be reasonable.”
